

EXAMPLE LETTER

If any company is trying to make you send them money and you have notified them that you do NOT want to be a member, the following draft letter, with a copy of their bill or your "Memo" of their phone contact should do the trick.

To Whom it may concern:

I have been harassed by your company concerning a debt you allege I owe. You have been notified that I do not want to be a member of your club. I do not intend to use your facilities nor pay dues/maintenance fees.

I am instructing you **do not** contact me further in connection with this alleged debt. Under the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, a federal law, you may not contact me further once I have notified you not to do so.

Violation of these instructions will be reported immediately to my attorney and/or the US Federal Trade Commission, **and to the appropriate Attorneys General.**
