Collection Agencies are Put on Notice !

A collection agency that tried to collect money from a former TAI member has been put on notice that they must stop such collection activity and that they must report all money that they have collected from TAI members to our attorney, Mr. Napier. Mr. Napier is the attorney for ALL members and former members of TAI in the class-action lawsuit.

REMEMBER: if you are contacted by someone demanding money in relation to your TAI membership, "You are represented by legal counsel (as are all TAI members in every state)." His name is:

Just tell them to contact your attorney. You are not alone, and you are not helpless as they might expect. Chances are they have collected money that they are not entitled to and we want it back!

If they call you, make a memo for record of all the details of the conversation and date it (or if you get something in writing) send a copy of it to Mr. Napier and ask him to make it stop.

I have met this man and I believe that he is a good person who really cares about us. He deserves our cooperation and support.

Refunds for Members-?

The Florida Chapter 7 Trustee, Mr. Cuthill, and his attorney, Mr. Shuker, have proposed that members who filed a proof-of-claim in the Florida bankruptcy should be entitled to a "REFUND" of up to \$1,800.

A HEARING WILL BE HELD IN THE BANKRUPTCY COURT IN ORLANDO ON
DECEMBER 2, 1998, AT 10:00.
YOU SHOULD PLAN TO ATTEND THIS HEARING.

If you have moved since you filed your proof-of-claim, be sure to notify the bankruptcy clerk in Orlando of your new address.

YOU WILL RECALL that our Committee advised you to file a proof-of-claim in the Florida bankruptcy. Some of you did and it appears that you may actually be getting some of your money back. NOW we are advising you to join the class-action lawsuit and file a proof-of-claim in the Iowa bankruptcy. No guarantee. Worth the effort to try.
