Good News about the TAI Lawsuit

We have been informed by Mr. Napier, attorney for former members of TAI, that he has recovered additional money for distribution to those members.

How much money each former member gets will depend on the number of people who file a valid claim for their share of that money.

So what is a valid claim?

A form like the one included with this newsletter must be completely filled out. Be sure to include your valid TAI membership number! Do this even if you got part of the first TAI lawsuit settlement.

Then mail the claim to Mr. Napier at the address on the form.

So what if you lost your membership number?

"If you were part of the previous distribution and received a letter from Mr. Napier about this new settlement, then he can use the mailing roster to confirm you are a TAI member."

Otherwise, the court will require him to verify you are a member in order to avoid having unqualified people find the form online and submit a request.

If you can produce a receipt, cancelled check to TAI, a dues statement, or something with your name on it, that will suffice.

- Every legitimate campground we know of will happily sell/lease camping privileges for a day, week, month, or a season. They will have a contract for you to sign. Read it to see if there are any 'gotcha' paragraphs. (Should tell you what happens if you don't pay as agreed or if you get behind in your rent.)
- Any campground you 'join' should specify the method to end the relationship - in writing and in the contract.
- Some campgrounds will rent/lease the exclusive use of a designated campsite for other specified periods of time. That's OK if you get it in writing.
- Just remember - "If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!"
- If they demand that you make up your mind immediately - RUN - DON'T WALK to the nearest exit and check your pocket to see if your wallet's still there.

Where can you meet nicer, more honest people than at a campground. Just remember, the people who run it... too often (but not always) might be crooks.

I have been to a lot of places, but I've never been in Cahoots. Apparently you can't go alone. You have to be in Cahoots with someone.

NOTICE TO FORMER THOUSAND ADVENTURES MEMBERS

You are receiving this notice because you have been identified as a potential member of the Thousand Adventures Campground membership class action lawsuit. You may have previously received a partial settlement from proceeds our legal efforts have been able to recover in the past.

I am pleased to announce that we have been able to recover some additional funds and the court has authorized me to make a disbursement of those funds to former TAI class members. If you are or were the owner of a TAI campground membership in one of Thousand Adventures 56 campgrounds, you are eligible to receive a share of these funds.

IN ORDER TO SHARE IN THIS SETTLEMENT FUND, YOU MUST FILL OUT AND RETURN THE ENCLOSE CLAIM FORM POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 28, 2012. Claims not received by March 7, 2012 or claims improperly filled out will not be eligible to share in the proceeds.

You must provide you TAI membership number or provide other proof that you owned a TAI membership. If you provide your TAI membership number, no other documentation is required. Other proof of membership would include an invoice for annual dues from TAI, a copy of your retail installment contract, a copy of the Guaranteed Resale Agreement, or such other TAI document with your name on it.
